



COMMUNITY CARE STATISTICS

Over the past 12 months, CrossPoint has served our community in some amazing ways. Through BLESS Weekend, Hope for Christmas and the BLESS Coalition we've touched the lives of thousands of people. While we can't correctly measure every act of community care performed by CrossPoint Groups and individuals, we can measure these events we participate in TOGETHER. The numbers below provide insight into these community projects, along with the time, effort and resources given to make them happen.



BLESS WEEKEND During our 2016 BLESS Weekend we built a community walking trail, hauled away trash from 350 homes, donated food to the Allatoona Resource Center Food Pantry and provided every homeroom teacher from Allatoona Elementary with school supplies.



HOPE FOR CHRISTMAS

Through Hope for Christmas we provided a great Christmas experience for families in need in the Allatoona and Bartow County area. Each family received food, gifts for kids, gifts for parents, coats and more. Our team of 500 people served 1,250 guests, giving away \$60,000 worth of food, gifts, coats and toys.



BLESS COALITION

The Bless Coalition has been created to give us the ability to greatly increase our project load and impact in the Allatoona community through local church and civil partnerships. Through the Bless Coalition another location of The Street Store opened in Allatoona in the Fall of 2016. Through The Street Store, 600 people were provided with winter clothing this year and we replenished the Allatoona Elementary School Clothing Closet.



In an effort to relentlessly pursue those far from God with the hope and love of Jesus, we partner each year with organizations both in our community and around the world. These partnerships provide our church the opportunity to give and serve in ways that set our partners up for success and make a lasting impact on the lives of people. *Below is a quick look at the impact CrossPoint made in 2016 through our partnerships.*

COMMUNITY

- We supported the Bartow Family Resource Center by purchasing diapers and wipes for mothers in need.
- During Love Month, CrossPoint Kids invested \$800+ in random acts of kindness throughout our community.
- We hosted our first Global Leadership Summit to invest in 100+ church and community leaders.
- We partnered with Family Promise Bartow to help find permanent housing and jobs for 17 homeless families.
- We served meals to the homeless twice a month through Friendship Table and Good Neighbor Shelter.

WORLD

- Our CrossPoint Students invested \$2,000 and time to build a Sunday School classroom in Nicaragua.
- CrossPoint Kids created Blessing Bags to send with our Bolivia Team to hand out to children in Alegria, Bolivia
- Our CrossPoint mission team built subsistence farm gardens, provided computers and medical programs to people in need in Alegria, Bolivia.
- We sent 2 teams to Burkina Faso to build Church Hangars (cost of each hangar is \$5,000) for the Djan people, an unreached people group.
- 103 unreached people in Burkina Faso said Yes to Jesus through the ministry of CrossPoint!
- 2 well drilling teams were sent to Burkina Faso and they dug a total of 7 wells.
- We supported Pastor Sylvan, our local pastor in Burkina Faso, to the Djan people.
- We gave \$1,200 to Café 1040 for missionary care.

Last year we launched NEXT, a bold initiative to raise the necessary funds to provide an expanded facility for our church in order to continue to reach the 260,000 people in our community with the hope and love of Jesus Christ.

In November of 2016, we raised an additional \$106,822 in one-time and pledged gifts, bringing our total given and pledged amount to \$1,431,907!
