READ

Genesis 1:1-2:3

SUMMARY

The book of Genesis begins with God creating the heavens, earth, and all life. He creates and gives everything order in six days, and rests on the seventh day. He also made humankind in His image, linking their identity to His own. The story of the Bible begins with God creating all things for His glory, and everything He created was good in His eyes.

REVIEW

Spend some time catching up over the past few weeks, and what God has been doing in everyone's life.

DISCUSS

- God's creation was made to reflect His glory. How can we see this in His creation and what are some of the things about Him you are reminded of?
- What does it mean to be made in God's image? How does knowing this impact our lives and the way that we live?
- God created everything and said that it was good. If God created everything, including us, what does this show us about the goodness of His Word (the Bible)?
- On the seventh day, God rests and makes it holy. Why is it important that we have a day of rest, and what does that look like in your life?
- Read John 1:1-3, 14 and Hebrews 1:1-3. What role did Jesus play in creation?
