Genesis 6:9-8:19

SUMMARY

In response to humanity's increasing corruption, God is grieved and decides to flood the earth. Out of a passion to protect the goodness of the world He created, God decides to wash it clean of its corruption. God does this through using a man named Noah, who was the only righteous man at the time. Noah then builds an arc, protecting his family and many animals from the flood. The flood is a reminder of God's calling for us to live as faithful witnesses of His judgment and grace in a faithless world.
