READ

Genesis 12:10-20

SUMMARY

A severe famine in the land forces Abram and Sarai to seek refuge in Egypt. As they enter Egypt, Abram is afraid that the Egyptians will kill him and take his wife because of her beauty so he tells her to say she is his sister. Sure enough, Pharaoh hears about Sarai and she is taken into his house. God then afflicts Pharaoh with plagues, being faithful to His promise to Abram, and Pharaoh sends them away.

REVIEW

What could you use prayer for specifically right now in your life?

DISCUSS

- What does this passage teach us about fear of man and how it affects our relationship with others?
- Despite Abram deceiving Pharaoh, God remains faithful to His promise to curse those who dishonor Him. What does this show us about God and His promises?
- This was a test for Abram and His faith. In what way has God tested your faith? How did you respond?
- When are faith is tested, we are prone to forget God. What are some ways that you can remember God in times of testing and fear?
